BIOGRAPHY

They call **DJ Blazita** “**The Hottest Chic in the Game!**” and not just because she often DJs in high heels and a skirt. Blazita is one of the **hottest DJs in NYC and the tri-state area** setting both the streets and clubs on fire including popular venues like Amnesia, Crimson, Ammos, Hudson River Café, Haven Lounge, Pranna, and more. Spinning an open format of **top 40, hip hop, dance, mashups, latin, and 80s-90s jams**, Blazita has a great ear for music and uses skill to control crowds. She mixes and drops hot records at the perfect time making her a powerful force at any event.

A graduate from Penn State University, Blazita started off as a radio personality and then learned to DJ with turntables practicing for years before rocking out at various events and area clubs. Knowing not even one person in the music industry, DJ Blazita made up her own name in 2003 and decided to pursue a career DJing. It was all or nothing with her mission being to take over the world. In 2005, Blazita moved to Brooklyn and **began flooding the streets with mixtapes** to gain the attention of Hip Hop and R&B music fans. Without a cosign from anyone famous or part of the “in-crowds” she has gone from nobody to being one of the most recognized club and mixtape DJs. **Beginning in 2008, Blazita was voted the best every year by her peers and fans alike at various industry events including The Justo’s, UMA’s, and the LatinMixx Awards.** In the Fall 2010, she took the stage as one of the only 2 females who **represented NYC at the ThisIs50 (50 Cent) Festival on Governor’s Island** alongside many heavyweight artists and DJs. Being of Puerto Rican decent, Blazita has also been recognized as one of the “**top 10 Latino NYC DJs**” in the **New York Post** solidifying her as “The Hottest Chic in the Game”.

Coming a long way from her childhood in a small town where she grew up listening to Funkmaster Flex and DJ Clue mixtapes, Blazita was ecstatic when **she was asked to spin on Flex’s show on HOT 97 FM “The Takeover”** last year. As the world was listening, Blazita represented heavy on the 1s and 2s for the ladies and her fans as the infamous bomb dropped. Funkmaster Flex even recognized Blazita’s talent for blending records taking her remix of The Dream ft Snoop Dogg’s “Gangsta Luv” and spinning it heavy on the radio for weeks. Blazita has also been featured DJing on radio shows such as **Sirius Hip Hop Nation and Shade 45, UrbanLatinoRadio, Thatshiphop, AlistRadio, and DTFRadio.**

From tearing down clubs and other special events to helping unsigned artists establish a buzz in the game, Blazita is a force who often makes more noise than a crew of DJs combined. Recently, she started producing her own party records along with the help of her long time mentor DJ UMC. **Her first releases (available on iTunes) “Swurvy on My Birthday” and “Get Naked” are setting the club on fire!** Blazita looks forward to continuing to represent and make an impact in the **clubs, mixtapes, and on the radio.** Check back there’s more coming soon!

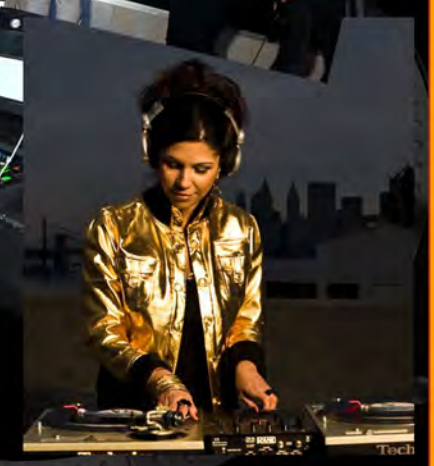

At this point any person who hasn't heard of DJ Blazita please come out from within the cave you've been being in. From rocking out clubs and other special events to helping unsigned and underground artists establish a buzz in the game, Blazita established herself as one of the most dynamic and respected DJs in Hip-Hop.

She started out as a radio personality at her high school's radio station and during her college days quickly garnered recognition for rocking out jams at America's "#1 party school," Penn State University. Hosted freestyle battles, interviewed special guests and spinning mix shows shortly followed.

Since then Blazita has been featured hosting radio mix shows on Sirius Satellite's Hip Hop Nation and Shade 45 as well as New York City's 91.5FM. Last year he was recognized as the "Best Female DJ" at the Justo Awards for her mixtapes. Her R&B mixtape series, Sex & the City: R&B Classics, also received two nominations at this year's Southern Entertainment Awards. It's pretty safe to say that Blazita has arrived.

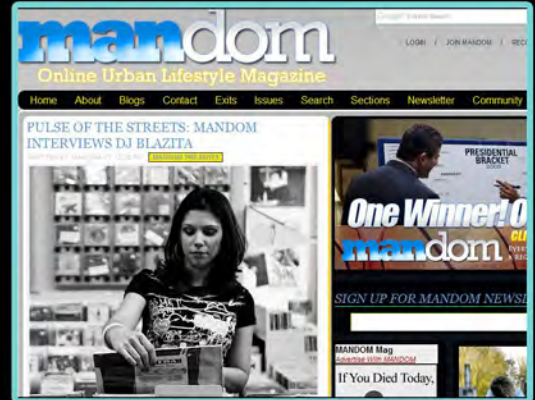

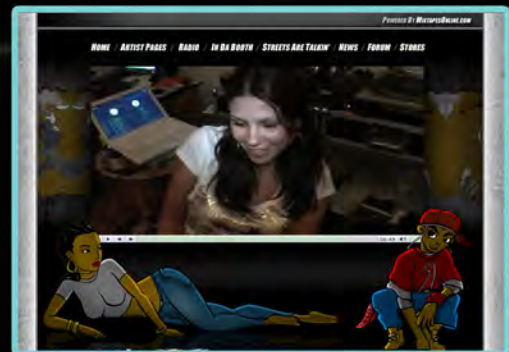
